

# HAVE I GIVEN ENOUGH AWARD

## The Steve and Penny Kubick Outstanding Volunteer Service Award

This award, hosted/sponsored by the Great Falls Chamber of Commerce, Military Affairs Committee, and 1st Liberty Federal Credit Union, honors the service given by Mr. Stephen Kubick and his wife Penny. The award recognizes Great Falls community members for their significant contributions to the Great Falls Community, including support of those who currently wear the military uniform, those who have served our nation and their families in an active duty, guard, or reserve role. The award element consists of a local artist community painting with Steve and Penny Kubick's Biography on the back. The award is presented at the Chamber of Commerce Annual Awards Banquet in September 2022.

1. The nominees must be serving in the local community.
2. Nominations must include facts and specific accomplishments that clearly state the contributions to the Great Falls community including support of those who currently wear the military uniform, those who have served our nation and their families in an active duty, guard, or reserve role, along with the various service opportunities the nominee performed and the results of the nominee's efforts. When applicable, nominations will include specific examples in any of these areas:
  - 2.1. Participation in Base and Community Activities.
  - 2.2. Articulate and Influential Spokesperson for the Base and Community.
  - 2.3. Voluntary Service in Great Falls Organizations and Activities.
  - 2.4. Contributions to the Youth or Public Education.
  - 2.5. Moral and Religious Leadership.
  - 2.6. Contributions to the Resolution of Contemporary Social Problems.
  - 2.7. Membership in Professional, Civic, or Cultural Organizations.
  - 2.8. Self-Improvement Efforts.
  - 2.9. Leadership and Other Accomplishments.
3. Anyone in the Great Falls Community may submit one nomination.
4. Submit nominations to the Military Affairs Committee in accordance with the official solicitation message.
5. Limit the copy to two typewritten pages (including headers/titles).
6. Send a biography limited to one single-spaced typewritten page.
7. Send a personalized citation summary for each nomination outlining why the nominee should be chosen as the winner.
8. Nominations for posthumous awards are accepted.
9. Please refer to the solicitation announcement for specific nomination package requirements and or changes.
